

**Isle of Palms Police Department**  
**Weekly Crime Report for June 25 – July 1, 2012**

Case Synopsis

**June 25: Monday**

Credit Card Fraud: Ocean Boulevard. Complainant of a local business reported that the suspect provided a credit card to run a tab for the evening; at time the credit card was processed later that evening, the card was declined and the suspect had left the business.

**June 26: Tuesday**

Theft From Vehicle: Carolina Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect/s stole an iPhone 4 from his unsecured truck while parked at his residence.

**June 27: Wednesday**

Trespass Notice: Forest Trail. Victim reported that an ex-boyfriend of her daughter was continuing to visit her residence despite being advised by her not to do so. An Officer contacted suspect and placed him on trespass notice.

**June 28: Thursday**

Burglary: Hartnett Boulevard. Victim reported that a known suspect had entered into their residence while they were out and stole monies that they had been saving.

Explosive Devices: 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. Officers responded to an explosion in the road where an unknown suspect/s detonated a homemade explosive device.

**June 29: Friday**

Attempted Suicide: Palm Boulevard. An Officer responded to the complaint of a suspect armed with a knife who was threatening to kill himself. The Officer located the suspect and took him into emergency protective custody. The suspect was transported by Emergency Medical Service to a hospital.

**June 30: Saturday**

Theft From Vehicle: Ocean Boulevard. Victim reported that an unknown suspect/s stolen her purse from her unsecured vehicle while parked in a private parking lot.

Disorderly Conduct: JC Long Boulevard. Officers responded to a complaint of two (2) suspects causing a disturbance at a business by attempting to agitating individuals in verbal and physical fights. At the Officers' request, one suspect left the area while the second continued to cause a disturbance and was placed under arrest.

**July 1: Sunday**

Theft of Bicycle: Ocean Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect/s stole his unsecured bicycle from underneath the residence he was renting.

Warrant Arrest: Palm Boulevard. While officers were investigating a possible crime, one of the suspects was identified as having an active warrant. The suspect was arrested and released to the police agency with the active warrant.
