Case Synopsis

July 10: Tuesday

Petit Larceny: 10th Avenue. The Isle of Palms Water Sewer Department reported that unknown suspect/s stole a manhole cover from a storm drain.

July 12: Thursday

Attempted Suicide: 32nd Avenue. Officers responded to a suspect threatening to harm herself with a knife; on arrival, the suspect had been restrained by family members. Suspect was transported to a medical facility by Charleston County Emergency Medical Service.

Swindle Game: 23rd Avenue. Victim reported that he had purchased two comic books over the internet; on arrival, the material was not in condition as stated. On attempt to return, seller advised that the material was not the same as sent.

July 15: Sunday

Public Intoxication: Ocean Boulevard. Officers responded to a report of an intoxicated suspect obstructing traffic. On arrival, Officers observed the suspect staggering in the South Lane of Ocean Boulevard. On contact, the suspect smelled of an alcoholic beverage, slurred his speech, and could not maintain his balance; suspect was placed under arrest.
