Case Synopsis

August 6: Monday

Burglary: Ocean Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) entered into the garage area of a residence where he was staying and stole a golf bag and clubs.

August 7: Tuesday

Motor Vehicle Theft: Palm Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his son's Eco scooter from the side of the residence at which he was staying.
