Case Synopsis

September 17: Monday

Grand Larceny: Frank Sottile Lane. Victims reported that when they returned from vacation, several pieces of jewelry were missing. They suspect their son's girlfriend of stealing the items because the suspect and the victim's son were staying at the house while they were gone.

September 18: Tuesday

Grand Larceny: Beach near 8th Avenue. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole her beach bag containing her Rolex watch while she was walking the beach.

September 21: Friday

Burglary: Waterway Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) entered into her home and stole jewelry from her bedroom. No forced entry was found and no other rooms were entered in the house. Entry was believed to have occurred through an open garage door and a back unsecured patio door.

Vandalism: Hartnett Boulevard. Victim reported that while out of town, she believes her neighbor or neighbor's guest had damaged her mail box by breaking its post.
