Case Synopsis

**October 24: Wednesday**

Theft From Motor Vehicle: Cameron Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole two GPS units from her unsecured vehicle. Victim advised that she did not have SER numbers to the units.

**October 25: Thursday**

Burglary: Lagoon Villas. Victim reported that three paintings were stolen from his rental unit sometime in the last two months by unknown suspect(s). Property is managed by Resort Quest.

Simple Assault: Palm Boulevard. Victim reported that a co-worker pushed and placed his hands around his neck while they were having a verbal argument.

Burglary: Morgan Place. Victim reported that Charleston City Police had arrested a suspect who had stolen his boat by breach of trust and that the same suspect had stayed at his residence on the Isle of Palms on October 20<sup>th</sup> with his brother. Victim had his brother go back to the residence where it appeared that someone (possibly the suspect) had been sleeping there and left personal items at the residence; the victim's car was stolen from the garage. The car was later located by the Charleston City Police Department on Vanderhorst Street.
