Case Synopsis

October 29: Monday

Criminal Domestic Violence: Hartnett Boulevard. A victim reported that during a verbal argument, his live-in girlfriend became violent, and began throwing objects at him because he would not marry her. The victim sustained a laceration to his cheek and several contusions on his shoulder.

Theft From Vehicle: Cameron Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole an outboard motor from his boat that was parked in his driveway.

Theft From Vehicle: Palm Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his wallet from his unsecured vehicle while he was at work.

Harassment: 30th Avenue. A victim reported that he had received two text messages on his phone from unknown suspect(s) asking if he did his English; five days later he received a profane text from the same unknown number. The victim believes the messages are from a former employee, but does not wish to pursue charges.
