Case Synopsis

June 30: Monday

Vandalism: Grand Pavilion. The complainant reported unknown subject(s) had damaged the lattice fencing to the storage area under the pool. Damage estimated at \$100.

Motor Vehicle Theft: Sea Shell Lane. The complainant reported his golf cart stolen after he left it for renters to use. The golf cart had been towed by IOPPD from the beach after it was found abandoned. It is possible the renters left it on the beach.

July 1: Tuesday

Theft From Motor Vehicle: Waterway Blvd @ Sparrow Dr. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) removed the driver side view mirror from her vehicle. No accident damage was observed at the scene. Value of the mirror: \$40.

July 2: Wednesday

Petit Larceny: Wild Dunes. The complainant stated she returned to Indiana after staying at the resort and discovered she had left her jewelry inside the hotel room safe. When the Manager on Duty went to check the safe, it was missing. Total value of the jewelry: \$1,108.

July 4: Friday

Simple Assault: County Park. The victim, a County Park employee, stated a female visitor became upset about the placement location of a beach umbrella. The female took the umbrella from him and threw it back at him, striking his chest area. The victim sustained no visible injuries and the female suspect was cited and released at the scene.

CDV: County Park. A female victim was punched in the face by her cohabitating boyfriend during an argument, causing bleeding and swelling to her nose. The victim went to Trident Hospital in North Charleston and then reported the incident. A warrant was obtained and the suspect turned himself in on 07/07/2014.
