Case Synopsis

July 15: Tuesday

Theft From Motor Vehicle: Ocean Blvd at Pavilion Blvd. The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) had removed various prescription medications from inside his parked vehicle. He was unsure if the vehicle was secured at the time.

July 17: Thursday

Burglary: 26th Ave. The complainant reported that a white female with dirty blond hair broke into her house back in March and removed a sapphire ring valued at \$1,400. The complainant did not report the burglary until now since she did not believe anything was missing at the time.

July 18: Friday

Burglary: 20th Ave. The complainant stated he observed two white males leaving the scene in a white pickup (possibly Ford) with a stackable washer/dryer in the rear bed of the truck. The washer/dryer had been left on the back porch of the residence (value \$75).

July 19: Saturday

Assault: Front Beach. The witnesses stated they observed a mother beating her 9 year old son in the parking lot after the child lost his glasses. Several witness statements were obtained and the suspect was arrested at the scene. The juvenile was turned over to his father after DSS was notified.

Petit Larceny: Beach at 9th Ave. The victim placed her bag on the beach while surfing and returned to find it missing. Total value of bag and contents \$305.

Petit Larceny: Beach at 10th Ave. The victim placed her bag on the beach while taking a walk and returned to find it missing. Total value of the bag and contents \$125.
