Weekly Crime Report for August 4 – August 10, 2014

Case Synopsis

August 7: Thursday

Burglary: Front Beach. The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) had entered his rental condominium and removed \$155 from his wallet and his wife's purse. A pry mark was discovered on the door but there was no other damage. A latent print was obtained from the outside portion of the door.

Vandalism: Morgan Place Drive. The complainant reported her rear door handle had been damaged in an apparent attempted burglary, but no entry was made. The Criminal Investigations Division was called to scene and collected evidence and obtained several latent prints from the outside portion of the door. This incident is possibly related to a similar reported burglary on Morgan Place Drive.

August 9: Saturday

Petit Larceny: Front Beach. The complainant reported that her iPhone was taken somewhere around the Windjammer between 9 PM and midnight (value \$700).

Motor Vehicle Theft: Yacht Harbor Drive. The complainant stated he returned after being away for a month and discovered unknown subject(s) had used his golf cart and returned it damaged. The golf cart was stored under a tarp in the carport area of the building. This incident is possibly related to several other golf cart thefts in the area around the same time.

August 10: Sunday

Assault: Palmetto Drive. The complainant (Wild Dunes Security) stated he was issuing a warning ticket to a golf cart operating after dark when the driver struck him in the side of his leg while leaving the scene. The victim was not injured.
