Case Synopsis

August 11: Monday

Petit Larceny: Beach at 9th Ave. The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) removed his unattended 9-foot surfboard from the beach (value \$400).

August 12: Tuesday

Burglary: Palmetto Drive. (Beach Club Villas). The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) entered her condo and removed a 39-inch television and a comforter from a bedroom (value \$500). Another television was found unplugged in the condo.

August 14: Thursday

Burglary: Front Beach. The complainant stated he returned to his room and discovered his wallet was missing. The wallet contained identification cards, credit cards and \$150.

August 16: Saturday

Vandalism: Morgan Place Drive. The complainant stated sometime since July 8, 2014 unknown subject(s) damaged the screen on the rear porch door of her home (damage \$25). This incident is possibly related to other burglaries and vandalisms previously reported in the same area.

August 17: Sunday

Assault: Front Beach. An intoxicated patron was assaulted by two males in front of the business. The victim was transported to East Cooper Hospital with head injuries.

Vandalism: Front Beach. The complainant reported his windshield on his pickup truck was broken by unknown means (value \$225).

Motor Vehicle Theft: Morgan Place Dr. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) took his golf cart and returned it with obvious signs of use and damage.

Motor Vehicle Theft: 3300 block of Cameron Blvd. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) took his golf cart and returned it with obvious signs of use and damage. This incident and the above incident appear to be related to other similar reports of golf cart thefts and vandalisms in the same area.
