Case Synopsis

August 26: Tuesday

Petit Larceny: Beach at 25th Avenue. The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) removed her unattended cellphone and GoPro camera from the beach while the victim was surfing. Total value \$600.

August 27: Wednesday

Petit Larceny: Yacht Harbor Court. The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) removed various items from the locked owner's closet to include two (2) bicycles, a toaster, batteries and other household goods. There was no forced entry to the closet and only certain people have the key. Total value \$1,295.

Theft from Motor Vehicle: 2300 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown subject(s) removed her cellphone and car keys from her unattended bag on the beach. The victim then discovered her car keys on the hood of her parked vehicle, and her purse and wallet had been removed from her vehicle. Total value \$305.
