Case Synopsis

September 29: Monday

Theft From a Motor Vehicle: 3000 block of Waterway Boulevard. The complainant reported that his Bank of America credit card was missing from his vehicle parked overnight in his driveway. The victim did not notice it missing until patrol officers recovered it on a traffic stop and contacted him. The suspect was charged accordingly.

Burglary: Wild Dunes. The owner of a rental unit discovered several items missing from a storage closet that was supposed to be secured. Items included bedding, cookware, cutlery, and a vacuum cleaner (value \$3,580).

Criminal Domestic Violence: Front Beach. Patrol officers arrested a male subject after he tackled his wife during an argument causing her to drop their infant child.
