Case Synopsis

October 13: Monday

Fraud: 2900 block of Palm Boulevard. The complainant reported that his credit card was charged approximately \$4,600 for 8 dancers to perform at a party and never received the service. The complainant is disputing the charges with his bank.

October 14: Tuesday

Breach of Trust: 2600 block of Palm Boulevard. The complainant stated she let a subject use her debit card and pin# to purchase supplies from Lowes in order to do work on her home. She later noticed several unauthorized ATM withdrawals totaling approximately \$500.

October 15: Wednesday

Vandalism: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. The complainant stated an unknown male subject keyed her car after a dispute over a parking space. Damage estimated at \$200.

October 18: Saturday

Burglary: Back Court. The complainant stated three televisions were missing from inside his rental property. The house has been under renovation and several different companies have been working inside since 10/15/2014. Total value of the missing TVs \$800.

October 19: Sunday

Motor Vehicle Theft: Morgan Place Drive. Three juveniles were arrested while joyriding in a stolen golf cart around 01:45 AM. The owner did not realize her golf cart had been taken until officers contacted her. Value of the recovered golf cart \$5,000.
