Case Synopsis

October 20: Monday

Petit Larceny: 5800 block of Palmetto Drive. The complainant reported that his wife's diamond ring was stolen while staying at the incident location three weeks prior. Value \$750.

October 24: Friday

Vandalism: 27th Avenue. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) threw eggs at the rear of her house, striking her window and screen porch causing minimal damage to the screen (\$30). A similar incident was reported near the 3000 block of Waterway Blvd with no damage.

October 25: Saturday

Vandalism: Sparrow Drive. The complainant stated his mailbox and post were knocked over and damaged by unknown means, most likely from a vehicle colliding with it and leaving the scene. Damage \$75.

October 26: Sunday

Burglary: 2500 block of Cameron Boulevard. The complainant stated he returned to the construction site and discovered that unknown subject(s) had removed a large amount of tools from the garage area where they had been stored overnight. Total value \$3,900.
