Case Synopsis

October 29: Wednesday

Assault: Intracoastal Court. The complainant reported that her sister struck her in her face during an argument causing a small bruise under her chin. An arrest warrant has been obtained for the suspect.

Vandalism: Forest Trail. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) damaged his golf cart sometime during the summer but he did not report it until recently after hearing that IOPPD made recent arrests for the same type of incident. Damage \$1,000.

Grand Larceny: Seagrass Lane. The complainant stated two rings and a pair of earrings were missing from her residence (value \$37,500). The complainant further stated only the cleaning service had been in the residence during the time frame (since 08/19/2014).
