Case Synopsis

**November 10: Monday**

Grand Larceny: Charleston Boulevard. The complainant reported that her patio furniture was removed from her porch after it was discovered by the property manager. Value \$2,400.

Petit Larceny: Wild Dunes. The complainant reported two televisions (new in box) missing from the lobby area. Value \$1,300.
