Case Synopsis

December 2: Tuesday

Theft From a Motor Vehicle: 9000 Palmetto Drive. The complainant reported his .38 Smith & Wesson revolver missing from his unsecured vehicle parked at the incident location. The pistol was taken between 7:00 AM and 2:00 PM. Value \$500.

December 3: Wednesday

Motor Vehicle Theft: 26th Avenue. The complainant reported her blue Clubcar golf cart missing from her front yard taken between the hours of 1:30 PM and 3:40 PM. Value \$6,000.

December 4: Thursday

Vandalism: 2300 block of Cameron Boulevard. The complainant reported that unknown subject drove a vehicle in a circle through his front yard causing \$1,000 in damage to the lawn.

Petit Larceny: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. Patrol officers arrested three juveniles that had just removed a shopping cart from the business and were riding the cart up Waterway Boulevard. The three juveniles were turned over to their parents.
