Case Synopsis

**April 27 – Monday**

Vandalism: 1100 Ocean Boulevard. The complainant stated an unknown white female shopper in the store removed a mug from the shelf, urinated into the mug and placed it back on the shelf. This incident was captured on store video. The mug had to be destroyed, valued at \$5.

**May 2 – Saturday**

Assault: 4600 block of Palm Boulevard. Patrol officers arrested a male subject after he inappropriately placed his hands on a female security guard and made sexual comments to her.

Theft from a Motor Vehicle: Palm Boulevard @ 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue. The victim reported unknown subject(s) broke the passenger window of her vehicle and removed a wallet and contents. The victim's credit card was used shortly after at a nearby business on Palm Boulevard, for a purchase totaling \$60.15. Video of the purchase is being reviewed.

**May 3 – Sunday**

Burglary: Grand Pavilion Boulevard. The complainant returned to his vacation home after three weeks and discovered two televisions, a vacuum cleaner and a toolbox were missing. There were no signs of forced entry, but a hidden spare key had been moved. Total value of property missing is \$1,225.
