Case Synopsis

June 8 – Monday

Fraud: 44th Avenue. The complainant stated a credit card account had been opened fraudulently in her name. Charges to the account totaled \$86.40.

Burglary: 55th Avenue. The property manager reported nine 19-inch televisions missing from the rental property.
