Case Synopsis

June 16 – Tuesday

Harassment: 1200 block of Palm Boulevard. The complainant stated loud banging noises had been coming from the business above his and that he believes it is being done on purpose in retaliation for firing an employee recently. A second report was made on 06/18/2015 regarding obscene drawings made on the business window.

Fraud: 900 block of Carolina Boulevard. The complainant stated she was informed by a business in Georgia that an unidentified female had unsuccessfully attempted to open a credit account using her personal identity information.

Petit Larceny: Waterway Island Drive. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) removed two signs that warned against jumping or fishing from the bridge.
