Case Synopsis

June 22 – Monday

Vandalism: Intracoastal Court. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) damaged her three lawn chairs on her back porch with an unknown sharp object.

Fraud: Dunes Ridge Drive. The complainant stated she returned from out of the country and discovered 6 unauthorized charges had been made to her credit card.

Burglary: Oyster Row. The complainant stated he was missing a large amount of jewelry that has not been seen since October of last year.

Petit Larceny: 24th Avenue. The complainant reported several items missing from the business. Most items were recovered at pawn shops and a suspect has been developed.

Vandalism: Municipal Lot. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) damaged the parking attendant shelter, most likely caused by a collision with a vehicle.

Vandalism: 700 block of Carolina Boulevard. The complainant stated she discovered pry marks on her front door.

Vandalism: 2500 block of Hartnett Boulevard. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) damaged two vehicles parked overnight in the driveway.
