Case Synopsis

**July 6 – Monday**

Petit Larceny: 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue Beach Access. The newly placed sign prohibiting vehicles beyond the access was discovered missing.

**July 7 – Tuesday**

Vandalism: Sandcrab Court. The complainant stated he discovered damage to one of his golf cart tires that appeared intentional.

Vandalism: 6800 block of Back Bay Drive. Five separate mailboxes were damaged overnight by unknown means.
