Case Synopsis

January 07: Monday

Harassing Phone Calls: Waterway Boulevard. A victim advised that a past boyfriend has been texting and calling her; threatening to send lewd pictures of her to friends and family if she did not return his communication.

January 09: Wednesday

Criminal Domestic Violence: Palmetto Drive. A victim reported that her live-in boyfriend had pushed her, stolen her car keys to keep her from leaving, and was attempting to force open the bedroom door where she was hiding because she was in fear of him. Property is a rental through Deserving Vacations.

Burglary: 52nd Avenue. A complainant advised that unknown suspect(s) entered through unlocked doors and stole four (4) TVs and wall mounts from the residence. The property is a rental through Carolina Costal Properties.

Petit Larceny: Hartnett Boulevard. Several victims reported that they believe a bag containing personal information was stolen from their residence by a roommate, who was no longer living at the location, but was paying rent. This was believed because of past conflicts between them.

Criminal Domestic Violence: Waterway Island Drive. A victim reported that her live-in boyfriend had assaulted her by striking her in the face and body to include pulling her hair and strangling her.
