Case Synopsis

May 06: Monday

Grand Larceny: Palm Boulevard. Complainant reported that a possible known suspect stole two (2) pumps from the Boathouse Restraint.

Vandalism: Palm Boulevard. Complainant advised that unknown subjects(s) forced open the lift arm at Gate 2 of Wild Dunes, causing damage.
