Case Synopsis

June 17: Monday

Petit Larceny: Sea Cabins Beach Access Path. The victim reported that unknown person(s) stole his pair of sandals, which he had left unattended at the end of the beach access path.

Motor Vehicle Theft/Breach of Trust: Fairway Oaks Lane. The victim reported that he had allowed his ex-girlfriend use his vehicle to go to the Kangaroo Express. The ex-girlfriend failed to return the vehicle, which was eventually located in Anderson, South Carolina. The case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division who prepared and secured warrants for the perpetrator's arrest.

June 18: Tuesday

Theft From Motor Vehicle: Palmetto Drive. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her unlocked vehicle and stole her iPad. Tracking software indicated that the device was located in the area of 1400 Moultrie Street in Mt. Pleasant. The Mt. Pleasant Police Department was contacted to assist in the investigation and responded to the area to search for the device, with negative results. The victim was not able to provide the serial number for the device at the time of reporting, however, will forward the information to an Investigator as soon as it is located.

Petit Larceny: Beach @ 55th Avenue. The victim reported that he left his backpack containing his mobile telephone and wallet unattended on the beach as he entered the surf to fish. Upon returning to the location where he left his pack, he found it to be missing.

June 23: Sunday

Theft From Motor Vehicle: Hartnett Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his unsecured vehicle and stole his wallet. The vehicle was parked in the victim's drive at the time of the incident.
