Case Synopsis

**September 23: Monday**

Burglary: Ocean Boulevard. A victim reported that a cleaning crew had removed his family's personal property from a rental unit by mistake, thinking that the family had already checked out. The cleaning crew, according to the victim, took all of the property to the rental agency through which the unit was rented. When the victim responded to the rental company to retrieve her property, it was determined that her acoustic guitar was missing.
