July 19 – Tuesday

Theft of Motor Vehicle: Palmetto Drive, The Villages. 4 males were captured on surveillance video removing a rental low speed vehicle from the parking garage. Shortly after, the vehicle crashed into a home at Grand Pavilion and the subjects fled the scene.

July 20 – Wednesday

Fraud: 31st Ave. Victim reported a Pay Pal account opened in her name without her knowledge or permission.

July 21 – Thursday

Burglary: Intracoastal Ct. Victim reported a lawn mower and several ladders removed from a storage room under the house.

July 22 – Friday

Theft of Motor Vehicle: Palmetto Dr., Ocean Club Villas. After an officer on patrol noticed juveniles on a golf cart, matching the description of the subjects from the stolen LSV, the juveniles abandoned the cart and fled. The vehicle was traced to the above location and confirmed as stolen.
