

ORDINANCE 2009-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 3, BEACH AND MARINE RECREATION REGULATIONS, OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT ABANDONMENT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY ON THE BEACH AND LEAVING THE BEACH IN AN UNSAFE CONDITION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1: That Section 7-3-14 Use of the beach (c) is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(c) Any personal property, except "Hobie Cat" style sailboats or permanently affixed poles supporting volleyball nets existing on the date of adoption of this Section, left unattended on the beach after sunset shall be deemed abandoned and subject to disposal by the City.”

SECTION 2: That should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable therefrom and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance take effect and be in full force immediately.
