

ORDINANCE 2009-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEASING OF THE ISLE OF PALMS CITY MARINA AND THE FRONT BEACH PARKING LOTS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF ISLE PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Findings.

South Carolina Code Section 5-7-260 requires that the City adopt an ordinance to authorize the leasing of any real estate owned by the City.

SECTION 2. That City Council hereby authorizes the leasing of the real property commonly known as the Isle of Palms City Marina and the two front beach parking lots.

SECTION 3. That should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable therefrom and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance take effect and be in full force immediately.
