

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISLE OF PALMS, SOUTH CAROLINA, URGING ALL CITIZENS, RESIDENTS, TOURISTS AND VISITORS TO WEAR PROTECTIVE FACE MASKS ANYTIME THEY ARE OUTSIDE OF THEIR HOME OR PLACE OF LODGING

WHEREAS, On March 16, 2020, our Mayor, under the authority of § 1-2-5, Municipal Code of the City of Isle of Palms, declared that a State of Emergency exists throughout the City as a result of impacts arising from the COVID-19 pandemic; and


WHEREAS, the Governor of South Carolina issued Executive Order 2020-30 on May 1, 2020, which rescinded the mandatory self-quarantine and lodging and travel restrictions for individuals entering South Carolina from high risk areas; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of South Carolina issued Executive Order 2020-31 on May 1, 2020, which modified his previously issued Home or Work Order thereby allowing for greater access and use of commercial establishments to include permitting outdoor dining at restaurants; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is necessary to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of its residents, tourists, and visitors, that all individuals should be encouraged to wear appropriate face masks anytime they may be in a public setting that could bring them into contact with other people outside of their family unit and to continue their practice of safety measures recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control.


