## SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Special Meeting of City Council was called to order at 6:20 p.m., Tuesday, December 1, 2015 in Council Chambers of City Hall, 1207 Palm Boulevard, Isle of Palms, South Carolina.
