A Special Meeting of City Council was held at 5:30 p.m., Tuesday, July 26, 2016 in Council Chambers, City Hall, 1207 Palm Boulevard, Isle of Palms, South Carolina; attending the meeting were Councilmembers Bergwerf, Carroll, Ferencz, Harrington, Kinghorn Rice and Ward, Mayor Cronin, Administrator Tucker, Attorney Halversen, Assistant Administrator Fragoso, and Clerk Copeland; a quorum was present to conduct business. Councilmember Bettelli was absent. Attorney Brent Halversen, who has represented the City in litigation with The Beach Property Owners Association, Inc., was also present to update Council on the status of the case.
