

## **SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL**

5:00 p.m., Thursday, October 23, 2008

The Special Meeting of the City Council was held at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, October 23, 2008 in Council Chambers of City Hall, 1207 Palm Boulevard, Isle of Palms, South Carolina. Present for the meeting were Council members Bettelli, Buckhannon, Duffy, Loftus, Piening and Rice, Mayor Sottile, City Administrator Tucker, City Attorney Sottile, Building Director Kerr, Assistant to the Administrator Dziuban and City Clerk Copeland. The absences of Council members Cronin and Taylor were excused. There was a quorum present to conduct business.

1. Mayor Sottile called the meeting to order and acknowledged that the press and the public had been duly notified of the meeting in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act.
2. Mayor Sottile explained that the purpose of this Special Meeting was for the Council to receive legal advice on the re-codification of the City code. The essence of the re-codification was to ensure consistency throughout the code, to remove any contradictions and to update the City code to reflect changes to state and federal laws.
