**Call Summary**

*March 2010*

- 3/2/10 Personnel responded to motor vehicle accident where a vehicle struck a building on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival, crew attended to the driver and passenger until arrival of Charleston County EMS. The car battery was disabled by the Fire Department. A palm tree was cut up and moved. Fire Department secured area with caution tape and notified the Property Manager and Building Department.
- 3/8/10 Personnel responded to a report of a possible fire on Goat Island. Boat 1 investigated and found a fire controlled by the homeowner. After checking for possible threat or loss of fire control, Boat 1's crew returned to the station.
- 3/13/10 Personnel responded to a 34' power boat sinking at the dock behind the owner's residence. The boat was submerged approximately 75 percent and fuel and oil were leaking. Department of Health and Environmental Control, Department of Natural Resources and U.S. Coast Guard were notified. Fire Department remained on scene after arrival of U.S.C.G. for fire control. A salvage company arrived and took responsibility for raising vessel and securing the leaks.
- 3/23/10 Personnel responded to an area of Rifle Range Road to stand by for Awendaw Fire District. Awendaw Fire District was fighting a woods fire on Rifle Range Road.

All career personnel received training on fire attack, water supply, and fire streams.

Medical in-service training covered Behavioral and Psychiatric Disorders, Environmental Conditions, Gynecology, and Obstetrics.

All volunteer personnel received training on fire streams and personal protective equipment.

All fire department staff and on-duty personnel participated in the city-wide Municipal Emergency Operations Center exercise held at the beginning of the month. The drill was conducted to evaluate the city's readiness to respond in the event of a disaster.

Captain Bob Maibach served as Lead Instructor for the S.C. Fire Academy's Aerial Operations course taught at the Goose Creek Rural Fire Department.

Lieutenant Richard Hathaway and Fire Inspector Mike Hommel successfully completed the Intermediate Incident Command System course taught through the United States Coast Guard and the Charleston County Emergency Preparedness Division. The 2 ½ day course was held at the Charleston County Public Services Building in North Charleston.

The S.C. Fire Academy hosted the annual Southeastern Fire School this month. Engineers Dave Micalizzi and Dana Burnette attended a two-day seminar entitled "Nightmare in West Warwick: Managing a Worst Case Scenario." This program discussed the nightclub fire that killed 100 people and the aftermath of the incident. Engineer Chris Puckhaber attended the two-day "Defensive Fire Operations" program. The classroom and practical sessions demonstrated how to deploy personnel safely and efficiently when applying defensive firefighting tactics.

Engineers Dave Micalizzi and Ryan O'Shea successfully completed a 3-day National Fire Academy program entitled Fire Inspection Principles and Practices. This class was taught through the state fire academy and was the first outside course hosted in our new training room.

Engineer Dave Micalizzi successfully completed the National Fire Academy's Health and Safety Officer course. The 2-day program was taught by the state fire academy at the James Island Fire Department.

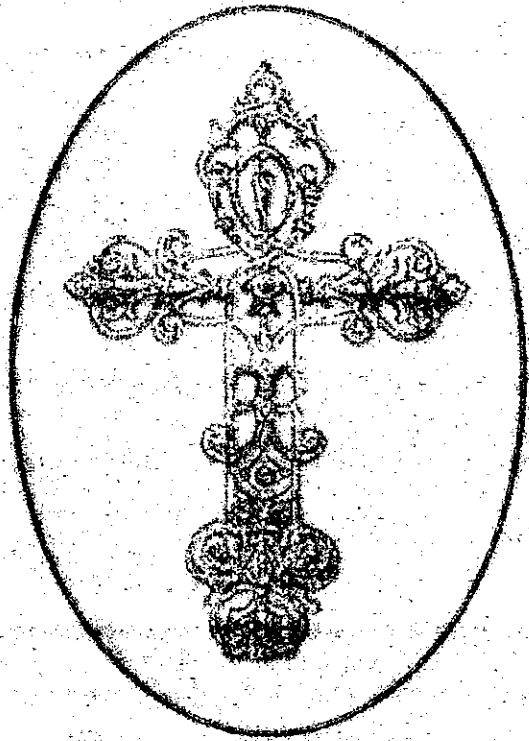

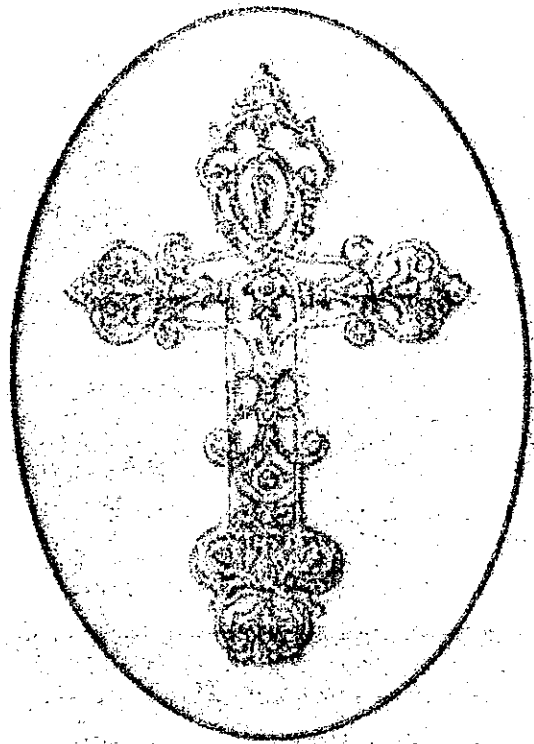
