### Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary

September 2010

9/12/10 Personnel responded to a residence on Dune Ridge Lane for a report of a missing teenager. A search of all surrounding neighborhoods was begun by fire, police, and security personnel. Engine 2 proceeded to the area of Yacht Harbor Marina where the family has a boat docked. Personnel found the teenager on the boat. She was transported by police department personnel back to the residence.

- 9/20/10 A resident called Fire Station No. 1 about having a dryer fire at her residence on Hartnett Boulevard. She believed the fire was out, but wanted fire department personnel to investigate. Engine 2 responded and determined that the fire was extinguished. They secured the electric breaker to the dryer and advised the resident to leave it off until the appliance was checked by a repair technician.
- 9/25/10 Engine 1 was requested to move up and assist Awendaw Fire Department with coverage while they were engaged at a structure fire in their district. Engine 1's crew staged at Fire Station No. 1 and responded to one medical call while on standby.
- 9/25/10 Personnel responded to a request from Sullivan's Island Fire Department to assist with two children in distress near Station 28 ½. Upon arrival, both children had been brought to shore and were fine. No further assistance was needed.
