Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary April 2011

- 4/2/11 Personnel responded to 57th Avenue to assist the Police Department with removing a suspect from an air conditioning platform at the residence. Police officers retrieved the suspect utilizing a Fire Department ladder.
- Personnel responded to a possible fire inside a residence on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival there were no visible signs of smoke or fire from the exterior. Crews entered the residence and found an electrical outlet in the bathroom had shorted out. Power was secured at the electric breaker and the area around the outlet was opened up to check for extension. Some charring was found in the wall. Property manager was advised to have an electrician look at the outlet before turning the power on.
- 4/13/11 Personnel responded to a parking lot on Palm Boulevard to investigate a vehicle leaking fuel. Upon arrival the vehicle had left the scene, but a small amount of gasoline was found on the ground. Crew placed absorbent material over the spill. The absorbent material was collected and disposed of at Public Works.
- 4/20/11 Personnel responded to search for a missing autistic child on the beach near the Citadel Beach House. Upon arrival the crew gathered a description of the subject and initiated a search. A short time later the subject was found walking southbound on the beach. Subject was returned to their parents.
- 4/30/11 Personnel responded to a condominium on Palmetto Drive for a person stuck in the elevator. Upon arrival the crew found a person stuck in a stopped elevator car. The person was very distraught. The crew utilized their elevator access keys to open the door and assist the individual from the elevator car. The person did not require any further attention and left the scene. The elevator resumed normal operations after the individual was removed. The property manager was advised of the incident.
