Call Summary
January 2011

- 1/1/11 Personnel responded to a report of a water leak in a residence on Lagoon Villas. Upon arrival crews found water leaking from an upstairs residence into the unit below. Fire personnel secured the water to both units and also shut off the main electric breakers to each unit. Property management arrived on scene and contacted their maintenance staff. Once the maintenance personnel arrived the scene was turned over to them.
- 1/3/11 Personnel responded to the area of the boat docks behind Morgan Cove Drive for a smell of gasoline. Upon arrival personnel found fuel in the water along several docks. The Coast Guard, the Department of Natural Resources, the National Response Center, and DHEC were all notified of the situation. The source of the leak was identified and the owner was contacted. Coast Guard personnel arrived on scene and took control of the incident.
- 1/9/11 Personnel responded to a report of smoke inside a structure on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found a light smoke condition on the fourth floor. Hand lines were pulled in to position for fire attack. An interior attack was initiated, but crews were called out as conditions worsened. An exterior attack was employed until the main body of fire was knocked down and crews could re-enter the building. The fire was extinguished, and personnel performed salvage and overhaul. During the post-fire investigation it was noted that the occupants of the residence were alerted to the fire by smoke detectors, and allowed them enough time to evacuate all occupants including an infant sleeping in an area immediately adjacent to the fire area. All utilities were secured during the fire attack. Sullivan's Island and Mount Pleasant fire departments were called to assist with this incident.
- 1/23/11 Personnel responded to a report of a possible building fire on Palm Boulevard. Chief Graham was the first to arrive on scene and found a small bush on fire next to the building. Crews arrived on scene and extinguished the fire. No other property damage was found.

Additional Training

All career personnel participated in driver/pump operator, fire ground operations, equipment familiarization, and water supply training. They also received training on the new self-contained breathing apparatus from Mine Safety Appliances.

Representatives from the Charleston County Rescue Squad gave a demonstration of their web-based motor vehicle information system. This software provides information on alternative fuel vehicles and special features to responders in the field.

Medical in-service training covered the cardiovascular system and the annual CPR refresher.

All volunteer personnel received training on fire ground operations and the new self-contained breathing apparatus from Mine Safety Appliances.

Lieutenant Roger Eagle completed the week-long Advanced Chemical and Biological Integrated Response Course in Dugway, Utah. He participated in the program as part of the county's COBRA team, which is made up of members from each of the county's fire departments.

Fire Inspector Jeff Anderson completed a course of training through the International Association of Arson Investigators. The web-based class was entitled "Search and Seizure."

Fire Inspector Jeff Anderson and Firefighter Stephen Goodwin successfully completed the National Fire Academy's Leadership I course held at the Goose Creek Rural Fire Department. The two-day course is taught through the S.C. Fire Academy. Captain Bob Maibach was the Lead Instructor for this course.

Firefighter Stephen Goodwin successfully completed the Fire Academy's one-day Responding to Utilities Emergencies course. The class was hosted at the Caromi Fire Department in Ladson.

The volunteer roster is currently at 10 members.

After a thorough check of the devices and their batteries, everything was found to be in good working order. The resident was reminded to replace the batteries every six months.
- 1/10/11 Engineer O'Shea, and Firefighters Goodwin and Richardson, assisted a resident of Chapman Boulevard who had fallen. Upon arrival, the resident was found sitting on the floor. They were assisted to a standing position and did not require any medical attention.

The homeowner was advised to have an electrician look at this device.
