Isle of Palms Fire Department

Call Summary

March 2011

- 3/1/11 Personnel responded to a residence on Marsh Island Lane to assist the police department. Upon arrival personnel set up an extension ladder so a police officer could access the residence from a balcony. Upon completing this assignment all units returned to service.
- 3/6/11 Personnel responded to a report of a fuel spill at the Isle of Palms Marina. Upon arrival, crews found an odor of diesel fuel in the area of the fuel pump running the length of the docks. After further investigation command was advised by officials from Dewees Island that the ferry boat captain had accidentally overfilled his fuel tank and the small amount of fuel in the water was from their boat. The U.S. Coast Guard and the S.C. Department of Environmental Control were notified. No further action was taken.
- 3/7/11 Truck 1 responded to Mount Pleasant to stand by at their Fire Station No. 1 while they were at a structure fire. The crew remained at the station until relieved by a Mount Pleasant unit returning from the fire.
- 3/9/11 Personnel responded to Ocean Boulevard in front of The Palms hotel for a tour bus on fire. Upon arrival, crews found fire in the rear engine compartment and heavy smoke coming from the passenger cabin. Fire attack was initiated with a 1 3/4" hand line, while it was determined all passengers had exited the bus. After several minutes the fire was extinguished, the engine compartment was overhauled, the passenger cabin was ventilated, and salvage was begun. Many personal items, such as clothes, instruments, and jewelry were removed from the bus and turned over to the owners.
- 3/16/11 Personnel responded to the Sweetgrass Pavilion for a fire alarm activation. While enroute units were advised of a light smoke condition near the elevator shaft. After checking the elevator shaft, personnel found a sump pump that had shorted out and was overheating. Power was secured to the pump, and the pump removed. Natural ventilation was completed and the alarm reset.
- 3/18/11 Engine 1 relocated to Mount Pleasant Fire Station No. 4 to cover while their units assisted the Awendaw Fire Department with a wild land fire. Volunteers responded to Isle of Palms Fire Station No. 1 to backfill.
- 3/18/11 Personnel responded to a request from the Awendaw Fire Department to search the Intracoastal Waterway for a missing person. Boat 1 was launched and began a search of the waterway moving toward the Awendaw area. After a short period of time, Boat 1 was advised the missing person had been found and the search was discontinued.

- 3/20/11 Captain Gadsden, Lieutenant Eagle, Engineers Carr and Micalizzi, and Firefighter Goodwin, responded to a report of a tree on the roadway on Morgan Place Drive. The tree was cut and moved to the side of the road for disposal.
- 3/21/11 Engine 1 relocated to Mount Pleasant Station No. 4 to cover while their units assisted with fires in Awendaw and Cainhoy.
- 3/23-25/11 Personnel responded over three consecutive days to assist with the wild fires in Awendaw. Personnel assisted with fire suppression, incident command, accountability, and staging.
- 3/30/11 Personnel responded to a possible structure fire as a result of a lightning strike on 32nd Avenue. Upon arrival, crews found no signs of smoke or fire, but they did find several areas damaged by what appeared to be a lightning strike. There was charred wood near the attic area. A thorough check of the area did not reveal any signs of fire. A large area of roof shingles had been blown off the roof. Crew pulled ceilings in the area of the damage to ensure there was no hidden fire. Salvage and overhaul was completed, and all units returned to service.
