Call Summary

November 2011

- 11/6/11 Personnel responded to a residence on 31st Avenue for a report of a structure fire. While enroute units were advised there was fire visible on the roof of the building. Upon arrival units found a fire in the built-in gas grill on the third floor deck. Most of the fire had been extinguished prior to the Fire Department's arrival. Upon arrival, crews checked for and extinguished the remaining fire, and secured the propane tank supplying the grill. The area around the grill was disassembled to check for any fire extension and none was found. All units returned to service.
- 11/14/11 Personnel responded to a residence on Waterway Boulevard for a report of a fire in the kitchen. Upon arrival, crews found a pan on the stove top burning. The fire was extinguished and the pan was removed from the building. The residence was ventilated and power was secured to the stove. All units returned to service.
- 11/24/11 Personnel responded to a hotel on Ocean Boulevard for a report of a person trapped inside a stalled elevator. Upon arrival, crews determined the elevator had stopped operating due to an island-wide power outage. Once the breaker to the elevator was secured to avoid a potential accident, personnel went to the 2nd floor and opened the elevator door. The person inside the elevator car was able to be removed through the door. The person declined the need for medical attention and the elevator remained secured until the power was restored.
- 11/24/11 Personnel responded to a residence in Grand Pavilion for a report of a missing person. Upon arrival, crews confirmed the missing person was a 20-year-old male. They obtained a description, and began a thorough search of the beach front area and the surrounding neighborhoods. After a lengthy search a police officer located the individual on Waterway Boulevard near 22nd Avenue. All units returned to service.
- 11/29/11 Personnel responded to a condominium on Ocean Boulevard for a report of a fire inside the unit. Upon arrival, crews determined a towel had been placed over a lamp and caught fire. The fire was extinguished prior to the department's arrival. Crews opened windows to ventilate a small amount of smoke. All units returned to service.

As such, it is the County's proposal to increase the radio user fee to \$38 per month. The fee increase will not begin until January 1, 2013 so that all jurisdictions will have time to adjust their budgets a year ahead of the fee increase.
