The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of April 2011.

## Patrol

(04/01/11)

Officers met with a local taxi company in reference to a complaint of vandalism. The cab driver reported that he had transported a group of approximately 18 people to an address on the Isle of Palms. After dropping the group off, the driver discovered that they had damaged several electronic items attached to his vehicle.

At approximately 3:00 p. m. Officers responded to a complaint of petit larceny. The victim reported that he was mowing his lawn and stopped to take a telephone call. When he returned to his front yard to finish the task, he discovered that unknown person(s) had stolen his lawnmower.

(04/02/11)

Officers were dispatched to the primary entrance gate into Wild Dunes, in reference to a fight in progress at 1:30 a. m. Upon arriving on scene, Officers made contact with two subjects that were occupying a taxi (van) and still engrossed in a physical altercation. Officers separated the subjects and summoned First Responders to the scene. One of the two subjects became increasingly belligerent and non-compliant with Public Safety personnel. He was subsequently placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

(04/03/11)

At approximately 10:30 p. m., an Officer conducted a traffic stop for a faulty equipment violation. While speaking with the operator of the vehicle, the Officer smelled burnt marijuana coming from within the vehicle. The driver admitted to having smoked marijuana in the vehicle. A search of the vehicle produced a quantity of a green, plant-like material that field tested presumptive positive for tetrahydrocannabinol (THC). The subject was charged accordingly.

(04/04/11)

While at 1206 Palm Boulevard, an Officer observed a vehicle pull into the parking lot and the driver exit the vehicle. The Officer further observed the driver's physical movements to be similar to those of an intoxicated person. The Officer met with the individual, and while speaking with him, observed in plain view an opened bottle of alcohol, a quantity of marijuana and several pills that were determined to be controlled narcotics. The individual was charged accordingly.

(04/05/11)

At 2:00 p.m., an Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 3000 block of Palm Boulevard for reckless driving. While speaking with the driver, the Officer smelled a strong odor of marijuana coming from within the vehicle. The driver admitted to having smoked marijuana inside the vehicle. Further, it was determined that his driver's license was suspended. After conducting a search of the vehicle, and locating additional marijuana, the subject was charged accordingly.

(04/08/11)

At approximately 3:00 a. m., an Officer was dispatched to Waterway Boulevard and Timber Lane in reference to a suspicious vehicle. Officers made contact with the two occupants of the vehicle, who were intoxicated and engaging in sexual congress. In plain-view, the Officers observed several open bottles of alcoholic beverages and a shotgun. The subjects were charged accordingly.

During the late evening hours, unknown person(s) damaged the exterior basketball court, located at the Isle of Palms Recreation Department by drawing and marking on the same.

Officers were dispatched to a residence in reference to vandalism in progress. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the complainant/witness and suspects. The suspects were charged accordingly.

(04/09/11)

Officers responded to a reported fight in progress at a local business. The victim stated that he and an old acquaintance had engaged in a verbal altercation, after which, the subject left the bar area to use the restroom facilities. Upon returning to the bar, the subject struck the victim about the head and facial region with a closed fist. Neither the victim, nor the establishment wished to pursue charges.

(04/10/11)

At 2:26 a. m., while on route patrol, an Officer observed a subject sleeping in a vehicle parked in the 1400 block of Ocean Boulevard. The Officer made contact with the occupant of the vehicle and determined him to be intoxicated and with a suspended driver's license. An open container of alcoholic beverage was located inside the vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

(04/13/11)

Officers responded to a complaint regarding petit larceny. The victim reported that there had been several service businesses in her residence, on the report date, and that she had noticed a rifle missing from her residence. The Criminal Investigations Division has developed a suspect and is in the process of obtaining an arrest warrant.

(04/14/11)

At 1:30 a. m., an Officer conducted a traffic stop in reference to an equipment violation. While speaking with the driver, the Officer observed an open bottle of liquor in the vehicle. The driver was placed under arrest. During a search of the suspect, a quantity of marijuana was found hidden in his sock. The subject was charged accordingly.

(04/15/11)

Officers were dispatched to a local business in reference to a shoplifting. The complaint stated that two white female juveniles had entered the fitting rooms with several articles of clothing to try on. After the juveniles left the business, an employee discovered the clothing missing and the tags discarded in the fitting rooms.

Officers responded to the area of Palm Boulevard and 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue in reference to a complaint of a reckless driver. Upon arrival, the suspect vehicle was located parked at the intersection of 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Palm Boulevard. The two occupants of the vehicle were engrossed in a verbal altercation and found to be intoxicated. Both subjects were placed under arrest.

(04/16/11)

At approximately 2:45 a. m., an Officer observed a golf cart being operated, on Hartnett Boulevard, without headlamps. The Officer made contact with the operator of the golf cart, who was found to be in possession of marijuana and a suspended driver's license.

(04/17/11)

An Officer observed an illegally parked vehicle on Ocean Boulevard, in front of the Seaside Inn, that was obstructing traffic. Contact was made with the driver of the vehicle, who stated that he was delivering food to the hotel. While speaking with the subject, the Officer observed an open container of an alcoholic beverage sitting in the center console of the vehicle. The subject was charged accordingly.

(04/18/11)

After conducting a traffic stop, for a seatbelt violation, an occupant of the vehicle was determined to have an outstanding warrant out of Pickens County, as well as an active suspension for Failure to Pay a Traffic Ticket.

(04/19/11)

A potential visitor to the Isle of Palms reported that he had referred to the Internet to search for rental properties on the island for his families' planned visit in June, 2011. During his search, he located a posting on craigslist's, which he responded to. After receiving suspicious correspondence from the individual that posted the rental property, he contacted the police department. Investigators determined the address to belong to a local business, not a rental property. Investigators are awaiting an answer from a subpoena served upon craigslist.

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered her unlocked vehicle, during the nighttime, and stole several items. The vehicle was parked in the drive of a rental property in the 2700 block of Cameron Boulevard. Investigators have developed suspects in this case, and are currently pursuing leads.

Officers met with the victim who reported that he had parked his vehicle in the 2500 block of Palm Boulevard to go to the beach. Upon returning to his vehicle, he observed three white males and two white females exiting his vehicle with a bag, belonging to the victim. The victim stated that he chased the five subjects a short distance, prior to calling the police. Investigators have developed suspects in this case, and are currently pursuing leads. Five arrests are imminent.

(04/20/11)

A victim reported that unknown person(s) had entered his unsecured residence and took, and carried away a number of personal items.

At approximately 11:00 p. m., Officers were dispatched to the boardwalk, at Grand Pavilion, in reference to suspicious persons; more specifically, a large group of individuals creating a disturbance. Upon arrival, the individuals fled the scene with the exception of one under aged individual that was too intoxicated to run. The subject's parents were notified and responded to the scene.

(04/21/11)

The victim reported that unknown persons entered his hotel room through an unsecured window and stole his laptop computer. Investigators processed the crime scene and located latent prints, which are being submitted to the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) for further analysis. Possible suspects have developed, however, cannot be confirmed until the results of the latent prints.

(04/22/11)

Officers responded to three different addresses on 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue in reference to vandalism. Unknown person(s) had vandalized all three properties by applying spray paint to various items on each of the properties.

(04/23/11)

A Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor was reported, that occurred sometime on 04/21/11, in the front beach area. Investigators have developed a suspect, and are pursuing leads.

(04/25/11)

Officers responded to five incidents of Breaking and Entering into a Motor Vehicle in the 300 to 600 blocks of Carolina Boulevard. Investigators have developed suspects and leads in these cases.

(04/26/11)

Officers were dispatched to a rental unit, in Wild Dunes, in reference to a Burglary. The victim reported that she had several pieces of jewelry removed from her unit. This case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

(04/28/11)

There were three additional incidents of Breaking and Entering Into a Motor Vehicle reported as occurring on this date. The Criminal Investigations Division has made three arrests of subjects responsible for these incidents.

(04/29/11)

At approximately 2:54 a. m., Officers were dispatched to a rental property on Ocean Boulevard in reference to a Noise Ordinance Violation. Upon investigation of the complaint, Officers discovered that 14 of the 15 individuals occupying the residence were under the age of 21, and were consuming/possessing alcoholic beverages and/or marijuana. All subjects were placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

### **Personnel/Community Relations**

(04/06/11)

Officers attended the career fair, hosted by Trident Technical College. A display area was set up and Officers provided information to the public regarding the City of Isle of Palms and the Isle of Palms Police Department.

(04/21/11)

Investigators attended an Isle of Palms Garden Club meeting to discuss crime prevention techniques, to include Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED).

For the month of April, officers discovered 62 businesses and 32 homes with open or unsecured doors. A total of 94 Victim of Crime Forms or Property Security Check Forms were issued to business or homeowners for various violations noted, or to advise that an officer checked their property during the night while on patrol.

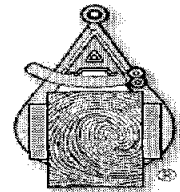

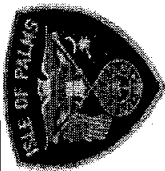
