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# ISLE OF PALMS POLICE DEPARTMENT

The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of August, 2011.

## Patrol

(August 1: Monday)

The victim reported that she was standing in her front yard when a female subject, occupying a white in color passenger car, stopped in front of her house and verbally assaulted the victim. The victim believes the subject was renting the residence next door to her and the verbal assault occurred as a result of the victim reporting a noise ordinance violation coming from the suspect residence the previous evening.

(August 3: Wednesday)

While on route patrol of the front beach area, an Officer observed a black male subject lying on the ground between a parked car and a curb. Upon making contact with the subject, it was determined that he was grossly intoxicated. Subsequently, he was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Facility.

(August 5: Friday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered onto his property and tampered with his pool pump. The investigation continues.

(August 6: Saturday)

An employee of the Isle of Palms Recreation Department reported vandalism to the men's restroom. The investigation continues.

(August 7: Sunday)

The victim reported that his ex-girlfriend responded to his residence and started a verbal altercation with him and his current girlfriend. The victim requested that his ex-girlfriend be placed on trespass notice.

While investigating a collision, the Officer discovered that one of the drivers of the vehicles involved in the collision had a suspended driver's license. The subject was charged accordingly.

A victim reported that a gym type bag containing a number of her personal items was stolen from the residence she had rented for the weekend. The case has been assigned to a Criminal Investigator. Suspects and leads have developed as of date.

(August 8: Monday)

A female reported being physically assaulted by her fiancé (with whom she cohabitates) and responding officers found evidence of such assault. Due to the fact the male was not home, and was unable to be located an arrest warrant was prepared and later served on the suspect.

(August 9: Tuesday)

A male visitor reported a gazebo-type tent stolen from the beach. Investigation continues.

A male driver was stopped for a traffic violation and found to be operating with a suspended license. He was cited and released for the charge and given an upcoming court appearance.

(August 10: Wednesday)

A female employee of a local restaurant was distraught after a coworker pointed what the victim believed to be a pistol at her while in the parking lot of the business. Officers located the suspect and the weapon, which was discovered to be a pellet-type handgun. The suspect faces assault charges from the incident.

A security officer at an island resort reported damage to an access-controlling gate on their property, occurring when a visitor manually raised the gate. A license plate was provided and an officer located the vehicle and suspect the following day. The female agreed to pay for the damages and the company declined prosecution upon receipt of restitution.

(August 11: Thursday)

A female resident reported the theft of an unsecured bicycle from her residence.

Officers responded to a report of a stolen purse, where the victim had the female suspect detained. Written statements were obtained and the suspect was charged with petit larceny and transported to the Detention Center.

(August 12: Friday)

Police and fire personnel responded to a residential structure fire, which was determined to be suspicious in nature. Local and state officials are investigating.

(August 13: Saturday)

A local resident reported two surfboards stolen from the area beneath her residence.

Police and fire personnel responded to a minor fire at a residential structure.

(August 14: Sunday)

Officers responded to a report of a domestic dispute. At the conclusion of the investigation it was determined to be verbal only and all parties agreed to separate for the evening.

After stopping a vehicle for an equipment violation the driver was found to have a suspended driver's license. The violator was cited and released, along with the vehicle, to a licensed driver.

A local resident reported a craigslist.com scam in which she corresponded with an individual regarding renting an apartment in Florida. After researching further the complainant discovered the actual owner of the apartment and was told the unit was not for rent. The female wanted the incident documented, as she had provided personal information to the suspect. The female suffered no financial loss.

(August 15: Monday)

A victim reported that he left his prescription medication in his the rental residence upon checking out. He notified the rental company, who advised him that the medication had been removed from the residence. The case has been assigned to Criminal Investigations.

Officers were dispatched to a rental residence in reference to a physical altercation that had just occurred. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the two female subjects that had been involved in the physical altercation. It was determined that the altercation began when one of the females accused the other of stealing \$40.00 cash from her purse. Neither subject wished to pursue charges, with one of the females agreeing to leave the residence for the remainder of the evening.

(August 18: Thursday)

Officers were dispatched to the area of 31st Avenue and Cameron Boulevard in reference to a disturbance. The complainant advised that a group of individuals were in the area, being loud and yelling at vehicles passing. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with a group of individuals who were consuming alcoholic beverages. The subjects were charged accordingly.

(August 19: Friday)

The victim reported that an iPod was stolen from within their rental unit. The case has been assigned to Criminal Investigations.

The same victim, as listed above, reported that her wallet was stolen from within the rental property on a separate occasion. There were no signs of forced entry into the rental unit. This case has been assigned to Criminal Investigations.

Officers were dispatched to 19th Avenue in reference to a suspicious person. The complainant advised Officers that a white female knocked on his door, stated she was having trouble with her car, then left the residence. Officers patrolled the area, locating the female. An information check produced an active warrant for the female subject, out of the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office. The subject was taken into custody and subsequently released to a Berkeley County Deputy.

(August 21: Sunday)

A victim reported leaving some personal items unattended on the beach between the Windjammer and public restrooms. Upon returning, the victim discovered that her items had been stolen.

(August 23: Tuesday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) scratched the side of her vehicle while it was legally parked in her driveway.

(August 25: Thursday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) scratched the bumper and side of her rental vehicle with an unknown sharp object.

Unknown person(s) entered onto a boat that was docked at the Isle of Palms Marina and started one of the two engines, leaving it to run approximately 8 hours; causing damage to the engine.

(August 26: Friday)

Officers responded to a local business in reference to a fight in progress. Neither subject wished to pursue charges. One of the two subjects was placed on trespass notice for the business. Officers responded to the Exchange Club in reference to a Burglary. The complainant stated that he had gone to the Exchange Club for a meeting and after entering the establishment, discovered a white male inside. The complainant advised Officers that he asked the male subject what he was doing, to which the subject stated that he was looking for a place to sleep then fled the scene. Officers patrolled the area and located the subject, and detained the same.

(August 27: Saturday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) took and carried away his catamaran, which was left in the dunes behind his residence. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

The victim reported that an ex-friend has been forwarding harassing/threatening emails and texts to him, and has verbally assaulted the victim.

The victim reported that she observed two subjects inside her open garage, when she pulled into her drive. When the subjects saw the victim fled the scene on foot. The victim advised Officers that none of her property was missing.

During the month of August, 2011, Officers issued 41 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 41 Victim of Crime forms completed.
