The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of September, 2011.

<u>Patrol</u>

(September 5: Monday)

Officers responded to an incident of Criminal Domestic Violence. The victim reported that she and her husband were engaged in a verbal argument that escalated into a physical altercation when he pushed her. The male subject was taken into custody and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.

A victim reported that unknown person(s) had deliberately punctured a tire on his vehicle, while it was parked in the drive of his residence.

A victim reported that unknown person(s) took, and carried away their property while they were visiting the beach.

(September 9: Friday)

A 17 year old male attempted to purchase alcoholic beverages with a fake I. D. at a local business. The cashier, realizing the identification card was fake, contacted the Police Department. The subject was apprehended and charged accordingly.

(September 10: Saturday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle equipment violation. A check of the driver's license produced information that the license was suspended for numerous failure to appear in court charges. The driver was placed under arrest. A search of his person, incident to arrest, further produced a quantity of marijuana.

(September 11: Sunday)

The victims reported that while on the pier, they were approached by a group of individuals, several of whom assaulted the two victims. One of the subjects, described as being a black male, approximately 18 years of age removed an iPod, a wallet and a cellular telephone from the pockets of one of the victims before fleeing the scene with three to four other suspects. Evidence was located and collected in close proximity to the incident location. Investigators are pursuing leads at this time.

Officers met with a male subject in reference to the theft of his company vehicle. The victim reported that the previous night, he had parked his vehicle on Ocean Boulevard to go to the Windjammer. While at the establishment, the victim stated he consumed alcoholic beverages and met a couple of male subjects. At the end of the evening, male subjects drove the victim to his residence. On the morning of the report date, the victim advised Officers that he took a taxi cab back to Ocean Boulevard to retrieve his vehicle, and discovered that his vehicle had been stolen, along with the keys. Upon investigation, it was discovered that the vehicle had been involved in a collision in the area of I-26 and Remount Road. The South Carolina Highway Patrol investigated the collision and reported that no one was with the vehicle at the time of their arrival. Further, a number of valuable items, belonging to the victim, were still present in the vehicle. The case has been assigned to an Investigator.

(September 12: Monday)

Officers responded to a residence in reference to a disturbance, more specifically, a female yelling for help. Upon arrival, contact was made with a female subject who reported that a verbal altercation with her husband, escalated into a physical assault. During the physical assault, according to the victim, her husband refused to allow her to leave the residence, destroyed her mobile telephone, and pushed her to the floor where he strangled her to the point of unconsciousness 6-7 times. Officers were unable to make contact with the male subject. The female was transported to the Isle of Palms Public Safety Building to await transportation to a safe haven. An arrest warrant was obtained for the male subject, who was subsequently taken into custody.

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had utilized his credit card number to make a substantial number of fraudulent purchases. Investigators are following up with the financial institution to obtain further information regarding the purchases.

(September 15: Thursday)

A rental property manager reported that a comforter was stolen from a rental property. The case has been assigned to an Investigator.

(September 17: Saturday)

Officers responded to the front beach area in reference to a fight in progress. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the victim who stated that the perpetrators had fled the scene on foot. A search of the area produced the perpetrators. While interviewing all intoxicated parties involved in the physical altercation, the victim advised Officers that he would respond to the Police Department at a later date should he decide to pursue charges.

(September 18: Sunday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had entered onto his property and damaged his flags, which were hanging from his house, by cutting the ropes used to secure the flags.

(September 19: Monday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her unsecured vehicle and took, and carried away her purse.

Unknown person(s) entered into the victim's unsecured vehicle and stole her company laptop computer and a quantity of cash.

An employee of a local business reported that unknown person(s) entered into the unsecured business. Once therein, forcefully entered two locked drawers and stole a quantity of cash and mini liquor bottles.

Officers met with a victim at his residence in reference to theft from a motor vehicle. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his unlocked vehicle and stole a pair of sunglasses and a quantity of cash.

(September 21: Wednesday)

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his unsecured vehicle and took, and carried away a laptop computer, an iPad, a pair of sunglasses, a watch and a quantity of cash.

(September 23: Friday)

A victim reported that a subject fraudulently obtained and used her personal information to open an unauthorized account with AT&T.

(September 24: Saturday)

Officers responded to a local golf pro-shop in reference to the theft of golf clubs. The victim reported that he had stored his golf clubs on a golf cart the evening prior. When he arrived to check out the cart for play, discovered that his clubs had been stolen.

(September 26: Monday)

Officers were dispatched to a local hotel in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival, they observed an intoxicated male subject standing on a 3rd floor balcony yelling. After speaking with family members of the subject, it was determined that the subject returned to the room, highly intoxicated and became belligerent when family members attempted to remove him from the balcony in fear that he may fall. The subject was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center for Disorderly Conduct.

(September 27: Tuesday)

The victim reported that an acquaintance of her family entered into her residence, without her consent or knowledge, and stole a quantity of cash, a gaming system and a laptop computer. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

Unknown person(s) entered into the victim's open garage and took, and carried away his bicycle.

(September 30: Friday)

The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered onto his property and stole his daughters bicycle.

During the month of September, 2011, Officers issued 34 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 10 Victim of Crime forms completed.
