Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary

February 2012

- 2/8/12 Personnel responded to a residence on Carolina Boulevard for a fire alarm activation. Upon arrival crews found no signs of smoke or fire and began investigating. After thoroughly checking the residence personnel were able to determine the cause of the activation to be a bad battery in a smoke detector. The resident provided the crew with a battery and it was replaced. All smoke detectors were functioning correctly and all units returned to service.
- 2/8/12 Personnel responded to the area of Goat Island after seeing a large volume of smoke coming from that area. A watercraft was launched and a crew proceeded to Goat Island. Upon arrival personnel met with a resident and determined they were conducting a controlled burn. The resident was advised of the proper notification procedure for a controlled burn and all units returned to service.
- 2/17/12 Personnel responded along with several agencies to assist with a land search for a missing person in the Francis Marion National Forest. Once briefed on the operation, the crew was assigned a search grid. Personnel utilized Fire Department ATV's to conduct the search. After several hours the crew reported to command that they found nothing in their search grid. All units were released by command and returned to service.
- 2/19/12 Personnel responded to a dock behind Morgan Place Drive for a report of a boat leaking fuel. Upon arrival crews identified the boat that was leaking diesel fuel. The leak had stopped and personnel placed several absorbent booms in the water to contain the fuel. U.S. Coast Guard was notified of the incident and all units returned to service.
- 2/26/12 Personnel responded to Breach Inlet for a report of individuals on the sand bar. Upon arrival crews determined the individuals were not in any distress, but advised them of the upcoming tide change and the dangers involved with the sand bars at the inlet. Once assured of their safety, all units returned to service.
