Call Summary
June 2012

- Personnel responded to a report of a trash can on fire at the County Park.
 Upon arrival the crew found a small fire inside a trash can along the beach access path near the Sea Cabins. The fire was extinguished and all units returned to service.
- Personnel responded to a report of a missing paddle boarder near Breach Inlet. The person who reported the incident said there was a group in the water and all had returned to the dock except for one individual. A jet ski was launched and after a short search the missing party was found in the waterway near the Isle of Palms Connector. He was not in any distress and the jet ski escorted him back to Breach Inlet.
- Personnel responded to a report of a building collapse in the front beach area along Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found a large section of the facade covering the underside of the swimming pool at The Palms Hotel had fallen on to the sidewalk. After securing the area, personnel from the Building Department were contacted. Traffic and crowd control was provided by the Police Department, and the Public Works staff provided a front-end loader to pull down a piece of the facade still attached to the building. After securing all potential hazards, fire and building officials met with the property manager. The property manager had already contacted a contractor to remove the remaining facade, and clean up the sidewalk area. The street and sidewalk remained closed until all debris was removed. Once the scene was clear, all units returned to service.
- 6/23/12 Personnel responded to a report of people trapped in an elevator at a condominium complex on Palmetto Drive. Upon arrival the crew found two people in the elevator between the first and the second floor. The crew accessed the elevator shaft from the second floor, and was able to open the door and allow the people inside to get out. No further assistance was needed and all units returned to service.
