Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary March 2012

- 3/13/12 Personnel responded to Hidden Bridge Drive in Mount Pleasant to assist the Mount Pleasant Fire Department at a structure fire. Rescue 1001 responded to the mutual aid request to refill air cylinders being used at the fire. After filling the air cylinders, Rescue 1001 was released by the incident commander and returned to the station.
- Personnel responded to a reported structure fire on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival crews observed heavy, dark smoke coming from the rear of the residence. As crews approached there was a bystander using a garden hose to control a fire on the back porch. Personnel finished extinguishing the fire that had started due to hot charcoal left in a grill on the porch. After checking further crews found that some fire had extended into the chimney box on the exterior of the residence. There was no extension to the interior of the residence. The chimney box was thoroughly overhauled and all fire extinguished. A property manager arrived on scene and was advised to have the chimney inspected prior to it being used again. All units returned to service.
- Personnel were dispatched to a structure fire on 42nd Avenue. Once all units were en route, the dispatcher advised the call was actually on 22nd Avenue. When units arrived on 22nd Avenue they could not find a fire, but then noticed smoke coming from the rear of a residence on 21st Avenue. Upon arrival crews confirmed a working fire at the rear of the building possibly due to a lightning strike. Personnel quickly confirmed that no one was in the residence and initiated fire attack from the exterior. Once additional personnel arrived on scene the hose line was advanced into the rear of the building and the remainder of the fire was extinguished. Crews placed salvage covers in the area of origin and began overhaul. A thorough check of all areas adjacent to the area of origin revealed no hidden fire. All utilities were secured and all units returned to service.
- Personnel responded to The Villages, Building B, in Wild Dunes for a report of five people stuck inside a malfunctioning elevator. Upon arrival crews received information that the malfunction was due to a power surge in the area and confirmed that five female occupants were inside the stalled elevator car. The elevator's exact location was determined, power was secured, and access to the elevator shaft was gained from the floor above. Personnel lowered a portable ladder into the elevator car and assisted the victims out and up to the floor above. All parties denied any need for medical attention and all units returned to service.
- 3/29/12 Personnel responded to Causey Pond Road in Awendaw for a mutual aid structure fire. Upon arrival the crew assisted the Awendaw Fire Department with overhaul operations. Once the assignment was complete, all personnel were released by the incident commander.
