Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary May 2012

5/3/12	Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 2 for a standby. Engine 1001 responded and stood by in station while crews from Awendaw extinguished a structure fire.
5/7/12	Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 1 for a standby. Engine 1001 responded and stood by in station while crews from Awendaw extinguished a structure fire.
5/12/12	Personnel responded to a motor vehicle accident on the Isle of Palms Connector. Upon arrival crews found a two-vehicle accident. After assessing the situation it was determined the extrication equipment would be needed to access the victims in one of the vehicles. A rear passenger door was forced open with the hydraulic spreaders to gain access. All patients were assessed and treated. Two were transferred to Charleston County EMS for transport to East Cooper Hospital.
5/19/12	Personnel utilizing Boat 1020 assisted the Charleston County Sheriff's Office in responding to an incident on Goat Island.
5/26/12	Personnel responded to the beach behind 2500 Palm Boulevard for a report of a capsized boat. Upon arrival crews found a capsized catamaran with three people in the water. The individuals were not indicating they were in any distress, and were attempting to right the vessel. Boat 10 Bravo was launched to check on the parties involved. After several attempts were made to correct the matter, the owner of the catamaran decided to abandon the vessel and contact a private company to recover it. All individuals were assisted back to the beach, the recovery company was contacted, and the Fire Department contacted the United States Coast Guard to advise them of the situation. All units were returned to service.
5/26/12	Personnel responded to The Villages on Palmetto Drive for a report of a person stuck in an elevator. Upon arrival the crew used their elevator access keys to open the car door and allow the person to exit. The person required no further attention and the manager was advised to have the elevator checked prior to returning it to service.
5/27/12	Personnel responded to Waterway Boulevard for a tree blocking the roadway. Upon arrival crews utilizing chain saws cut the tree and removed it from the road.
