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## Isle of Palms Fire Department

### Call Summary

*November 2012*

- 11/6/12 Personnel responded to a condominium complex on Palmetto Drive for a report of two people trapped inside a stalled elevator. Upon arrival, crews were able to access the victims and assist them from the elevator. Once all of the victims had been removed from the elevator, Wild Dunes Security contacted the maintenance staff and taped off the area to ensure no one attempted to use the elevator until the repairs were complete.
- 11/14/12 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire in Grand Pavilion. While enroute all units were advised the fire appeared to be out. Upon arrival, crews found a small fire in the kitchen that was already extinguished and a light haze of smoke in the building. Personnel opened windows to allow for natural ventilation and the immediate area of the fire was checked for possible extension. None found, all units returned to service.
- 11/15/12 Personnel responded to a report of a possible structure fire on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Upon arrival, crews found no signs of smoke or fire from the exterior. After a thorough investigation of the residence it was determined the source of the smoke was the HVAC system. The residence was ventilated and the owner advised to have the unit serviced. All units returned to service.

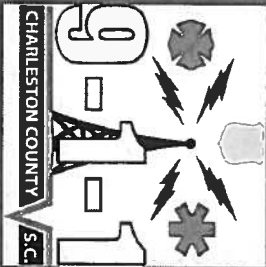
