Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary October 2012

- 10/14/12 Personnel responded to 41st Avenue at Frank Sottile Lane for a report of a vehicle in the ditch. Upon arrival personnel found a van that was partially off the roadway. No one was injured and a tow truck was requested to assist the driver. Personnel stood by while the vehicle was removed from the ditch and towed from the scene.
- 10/15/12 Personnel responded to the Isle of Palms Marina for a report of a boat taking on water. Upon arrival personnel found a 17-foot boat stuck in the pluff mud and filled with water. Personnel used the trash pump to remove the water from the boat. The boat's owner was able to have the watercraft towed to the boat ramp to be placed on a trailer and taken from the marina.
- 10/21/12 Personnel responded to a residence on 9th Avenue for an unknown type fire. Upon arrival personnel found some mulch had begun to burn underneath the HVAC units alongside the residence. The resident said they had lost power to several devices inside the home over the weekend. Personnel secured the power at the electrical meter and recommended they have an electrician check the home.
- 10/31/12 Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Station No. 5 to stand by while they were on a call. Once the Awendaw units were available, the Isle of Palms personnel were released and returned to service.

Additional Training
