The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of February, 2012.

## (February 1: Wednesday)

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a speeding violation in the area of Breach Inlet. After positively identifying the driver, information was obtained from the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) that the driver had an outstanding warrant through the Richland County Sheriff's Office for check fraud. The subject was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Facility for extradition.

The property manager of Port O' Call met with an officer in reference to vandalism. Unknown person(s) had cut the screens to a patio door of a unit in the A building. While investigating the scene, officers found the patio door leading into the residence to be unsecure. Officers made entry into the unit to further investigate. No one was inside the residence, nor did it appear that anything was taken from the residence. While on scene, officers located a second residence in the F building with the screens cut and an unsecured door. Again, officers made entry into the residence to ensure that no one was inside. Nothing appeared to have been disturbed.

#### (February 2: Thursday)

Officers met with a complainant at Island Laundry in reference to a larceny. Surveillance video from the business shows a white male and a white female stealing two washing machines from the rear of the business.

#### (February 9: Thursday)

An officer on routine patrol of the area of Palm Boulevard and 14th Avenue observed a vehicle disregard the traffic light. After conducting a traffic stop on the vehicle and speaking with the driver, the officer observed an open container of alcoholic beverage sitting in the center console. The driver was, subsequently placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Facility.

#### (February 10: Friday)

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 3200 block of Palm Boulevard for an equipment violation. While speaking with the driver, observed an open container of alcoholic beverage in the center console of the vehicle. The subject was charged accordingly.

## (February 11: Saturday)

While conducting route patrol on the Isle of Palms Connector, an officer observed a vehicle that appeared to be traveling at a rate of speed higher than the posted 55 mph. After confirming a speeding violation through radar, the officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The operator of the vehicle did not possess a driver's license; hence, was charged accordingly.

An officer responded to 8500 Palmetto Drive to meet with a victim regarding petit larceny. The victim reported that unknown person(s) stole two bicycles that were stored in front of his unit.

## (February 14: Tuesday)

While traveling along the Isle of Palms Connector, an Officer observed an equipment violation on the vehicle that was traveling in front of them. After conducting a traffic stop on the vehicle, it was determined the operator did not have a valid driver's license. The subject was charged accordingly.

## (February 15: Wednesday)

An Officer conducting routine patrol in the area of J. C. Long Boulevard and Pavilion Drive observed a vehicle being operated in a reckless and careless manner. After conducting a traffic stop, it was determined that the operator was driving under the influence. The subject was charged accordingly.

## (February 17: Friday)

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for non-functioning tail-lamps. Information was attained that the driver had an outstanding warrant from Massachusetts for carrying a prohibited weapon with violent tendencies. However, extradition was denied. The subject was released with a warning for the equipment violation.

## (February 18: Saturday)

An Officer was conducting foot patrol of the front beach area, during which time a vehicle was observed traveling down the wrong lane of Ocean Boulevard near the Windjammer. When the Officer made contact with the driver, it was ascertained that he was operating the vehicle under the influence of alcohol. The subject was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Facility.

Officers responded to an address on Cameron Boulevard in reference to a domestic dispute in progress. Upon arrival, Officers met with the male subject who stated that his wife came home from work intoxicated and was very belligerent. According to the complainant, his wife continued yelling and throwing things about the house, in spite of his efforts to calm her. It was recommended that the parties separate for the evening. A taxi-cab service responded to the residence and transported the female to her mother's residence for the rest of the evening.

## (February 20: Monday)

An officer met with a victim, at the Isle of Palms Marina in reference to the theft of a boat battery.

A second theft, from a boat, was reported at the Marina on this same date. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered onto his watercraft and stole a cooler.

## (February 22: Wednesday)

An officer met with a victim at her rental property, in the 5200 block of Palm Boulevard. The owner/victim reported that her property is managed by Resort Quest and that a flag was missing from her front porch.

## (February 25: Saturday)

Officers responded to a residence on 21st Avenue in reference to a call regarding a domestic dispute. While en route to the residence, dispatch advised responding officers that the male half of the dispute had left the scene. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a female subject, who appeared to be under the influence of alcoholic beverage and upset. The female reported that she and her boyfriend had engaged in a verbal altercation that never escalated to physical violence; and that her sister was coming to the residence to stay with her for the remainder of the evening.

During the week, there were four traffic related arrests. On 02/22/12, while conducting routine patrol of the Isle of Palms Connector, an officer observed a vehicle with in-operable license plate lamps. After conducting a traffic stop and identifying the driver, dispatch provided information that the subject had two active warrants out of an agency in Florida, five additional bench warrants for failure to appear in court for worthless check charges, and a suspended driver's license failure to pay a traffic ticket. The Florida agency refused extradition; however, the subject was placed under arrest for driving under suspension and failure to pay a traffic fine. A pre-tow inventory of the vehicle produced a quantity of a green, plant-like material which field tested presumptive positive for Tetrahydrocannibanol (THC), the active ingredient found in marijuana. The subject was, subsequently, the subject was transported to the Al Cannon Detention Facility.

## <u>Patrol</u>

During the month of February, 2012, Officers issued 98 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 32 Victim of Crime forms completed.
