The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of July, 2012.

(July 01: Sunday)

<u>Larceny of a Bicycle</u>: Ocean Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) took and carried away a bicycle from within his unsecured garage.

<u>Warrant Arrest</u>: Palm Boulevard. Officers were dispatched to the 4000 block of Palm Boulevard in reference to a possible larceny that had just occurred. Suspects were located, and while collecting personal data for the subjects, it was discovered that one of the suspects had an outstanding warrant with the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office. The subject was detained and subsequently, released to a BCSO Deputy for transport.

(July 02: Monday)

<u>Theft From A Motor Vehicle</u>: 32nd Avenue. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her unsecured vehicle and took her book bag and spare vehicle key. Through investigation, it was determined that the perpetrators utilized the victim's credit cards at various locations throughout the Tri-County area.

<u>Theft From A Motor Vehicle</u>: 32nd Avenue. A second victim from 32nd Avenue reported that unknown person(s) also entered into their unsecured vehicle, and once therein, stole some keys and an OHM meter.

(July 03: Tuesday)

<u>Cruelty to an Animal</u>: Lauden Boulevard. The complainant reported that he had requested a neighbor to sit his dog while vacationing. Upon his return home, noticed unusual behaviors in his dog. The complainant learned that his dog had sustained significant injuries without receiving medical attention. After receiving veterinary care, medical examinations confirmed that the dog had injuries consistent with being kicked.

<u>Theft From A Motor Vehicle</u>: 9th Avenue & Palm Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her vehicle while she was visiting the beach, and stole her wallet. The perpetrators, subsequently, fraudulently used her credit cards in the Charleston and Florence areas.

(July 04: Wednesday)

<u>Grand Pavilion</u>. An Officer conducting route patrol on the beach in the area of Grand Pavilion observed a white male subject possessing and consuming an alcoholic beverage. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with having an open container of beer on the beach.

<u>Vandalism</u>: Palm Boulevard. The complainant reported that unknown person(s) damaged a street light post that is located in close proximity to his property. Investigation of the scene indicates that someone may have driven into the pole and fled the scene.

<u>Criminal Domestic Violence</u>: Front Beach. The victim reported that she and her husband entered into a verbal altercation as a result of him reading her text messages. The verbal altercation escalated to a physical assault when her husband hit her hands in an attempt to dislodge the mobile phone from her grip.

(July 06: Friday)

<u>Court Order (Restraining Order) Violation</u>: Allie Court. The complainant reported that a subject was at his residence that he knew to have an active Court Order dictating [he] the subject; was not allowed to be at the residence. Officers located the person of interest, shortly after he departed from the residence. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with violating a Restraining Order.

<u>Underage Possession of Alcohol</u>: 25th Avenue and Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting route patrol in the 2500 block of Palm Boulevard observed an illegally parked vehicle and stopped to cite the same. As the Officer exited his vehicle, he observed four (4) male subjects behave in a suspicious manner when they observed the Officer. More specifically, one of the subjects abandoned a cooler when he saw the Officer, thereafter, immediately crossed to the opposite side of the street to join the other three subjects who had crossed upon obtaining a visual of the Officer. The Officer attempted to make contact with the subjects, however, all refused to acknowledge the Officer. The Officer dispatched a verbal command for the subjects to stop, at which point they did. Through investigation, it was determined that all of the subjects were under the age of 21 years old, and the cooler contained a quantity of alcoholic beverages. The subjects were charged accordingly.

(July 07: Saturday)

Obscene Performance/Indecent Exposure: Grand Pavilion. Officers were dispatched to the pool area of Grand Pavilion in reference to indecent exposure. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with several witnesses who stated that they observed a white male subject sitting in the pool area with his lap covered with a towel, obviously masturbating. The subject had departed the area, towards the beach on foot, just prior to the arrival of Officers. However, the subject was located and positively identified by witnesses.

<u>Petit Larceny</u>: Front Beach. A victim reported that she left her personal items unattended on the beach to go for a swim. Upon her return, she discovered her bag to be missing.

<u>Alcohol Violations</u>: Beach in the 200 block through the 1400 blocks Ocean Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol on the beach observed numerous alcohol violations. Three subjects were cited for having alcohol on the beach and released at their respective scenes.

(July 08: Sunday)

<u>Petit Larceny</u>: Front Beach. A victim reported that she left her bag unattended on the beach for a short time and upon returning, discovered her property missing.

<u>Reckless Driver/Narcotics Violation</u>: Charleston Boulevard and 3rd Avenue. Officers were dispatched to the aforementioned area in reference to a reckless driver. Witnesses stated that the operator of a passenger car had traveled through a group of trees in the 200 block of Charleston Boulevard, through a stop sign and fled the scene. Officers located the vehicle and placed the operator under arrest for leaving the scene of an accident, with fixed property damage. A pre-tow inventory of the vehicle produced a number of Aromatic Hydrocarbons. The subject was additionally charged with the Unlawful Use and Possession of Aromatic Hydrocarbons.

<u>Disorderly Conduct</u>: J. C. Long Boulevard. Officers were dispatched to the Public Safety Building (PSB) in reference to suspicious circumstances. Telecommunications Officers advised that an unknown white male subject was banging on the front door of the PSB. Officers made contact with the subject, who was determined to be grossly intoxicated. The subject advised Officers that he thought he was at his hotel and was just trying to get in, however, could not provide Officers with any information about where he was staying.

(July 10: Tuesday)

<u>Traffic Arrest</u>: 41st Avenue and Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting routine patrol in the 4100 block of Palm Boulevard observed inoperable equipment on the vehicle traveling in front of them. Upon conducting a lawful traffic stop, information was obtained that confirmed an active arrest warrant from the State of Florida and that the operator's South Carolina driver's license was suspended. Florida refused extradition, however, subject was charged with Driving Under Suspension.

<u>Petit Larceny</u>: 10th Avenue. An Isle of Palms Water and Sewer Department employee reported that an unknown person(s) took and carried away a manhole cover from a storm drain.

<u>Alcohol Violation</u>: 41st Avenue. An Officer observed a subject walking along 41st Avenue with an open container of beer. The subject was charged accordingly.

(July 11: Wednesday)

<u>Traffic Arrest</u>. 41st Avenue. While conducting route patrol on 41st Avenue, an Officer observed a vehicle traveling at what appeared to be at a high rate of speed. After confirmation of the speeding violation, a traffic stop was conducted, at which time it was learned that the operator of the vehicle had a suspended driver's license.

(July 12: Thursday)

<u>Traffic Arrest</u>. Beachside Drive and Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop in reference to an equipment violation. Telecommunications provided information that the operator of the vehicle did not possess a driver's license.

(July 13: Friday)

<u>Larceny of a Bicycle</u>: Fairway Oaks Lane. The complainant, a friend of the homeowner who was not at the residence, reported that unknown person(s) stole a bicycle from within an unsecured garage area. The Criminal Investigations Division later discovered that the bicycle had not been stolen, but picked up by one of the homeowner's triathlon teammates.

(July 15: Sunday)

<u>Public Intoxication</u>: Ocean Boulevard. Officers responded to a report of an intoxicated suspect walking in and out of traffic on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival, Officers observed the suspect staggering in roadway; more specifically, the south bound lane of Ocean Boulevard. While interviewing the subject, Officers detected a strong smell of alcoholic beverage emitting from his person, slurred speech, and noted the subject could not maintain his balance. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with Public Intoxication.

(July 16: Monday)

<u>Aggravated Assault</u>: Ocean Boulevard. A victim reported meeting a Hispanic male while a patron at a local business. While walking to her rental property, the suspect followed her in his vehicle; despite her telling him to leave her alone. From within the vehicle, the subject grabbed her arm and hair, and drove away from the scene dragging victim alongside the vehicle. The victim managed to pull lose and fell onto roadway with the vehicle running over her forearm.

<u>Burglary</u>: Hartnett Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her unsecured rental property stole an ice maker from the garage.

<u>Burglary</u>: Palmetto Drive. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her residence and took, and carried away jewelry from a bedroom dresser drawer.

(July 19: Thursday)

<u>Aggravated Assault</u>: Ocean Boulevard. Officers responded to a physical altercation between two individuals. During the preliminary investigation, the victim advised Officers that the primary aggressor struck him about the facial and head region a closed fist which was clutching a knife.

12-25260. Petit Larceny: Beach @ 57th Avenue. A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole his surf board from the beach.

(July 20: Friday)

12-25385. <u>Larceny Motor Vehicle</u>: 14th Avenue. An Investigator met with the victim who reported that her vehicle was stolen from Charleston County Park. While on scene, the Investigator was advised that the victim had received a call from her financial institution making her aware that unknown person(s) were attempting to make purchases on her credit card, which was inside the vehicle at the time it was stolen. The purchase attempts were being made at the Dollar General in Mount Pleasant. Both Isle of Palms and Mount Pleasant Officers were dispatched to the business, at which time the perpetrators were detained. After interview and interrogation of one of the subjects, it was discovered that the same subjects were responsible for a number of burglaries, thefts and vehicle breaking and entering on the Isle of Palms, Sullivan's Island, Mount Pleasant and Summerville. The victim's vehicle was recovered. Investigators are following leads, at this time. Additional arrests are pending.

(July 21: Saturday)

<u>Petit Larceny</u>: 41st Avenue. The victim reported that unknown person(s) stole a push pole from his boat while it was moored at a dock at the Marina.

(July 22: Sunday)

<u>Vandalism</u>: Frank Sottile Lane. Several victims reported that an unknown person(s) scratched their vehicles with an unknown object. The vehicles were parked in their driveway.

(July 25: Wednesday)

<u>Burglary</u>: Ocean Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into the unsecured garage area of the rental property and stole two bicycles and two bottles of wine. One bicycle was later located on the beach.

(July 27: Friday)

<u>Breach of Trust</u>: Ocean Boulevard. A local business employee reported that two male subjects had left the business without paying for goods and services.

(July 28: Saturday)

<u>Simple Assault</u>: 25th Avenue. An Officer responded to a local hospital in reference to a physical altercation that occurred between a father and his stepson. Neither subject wished to pursue charges.

Patrol

During the month of July, 2012, Officers issued 2 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 11 Victim of Crime forms completed.

The Police Department provided traffic control for the 4th of July Golf Cart Parade, as well as traffic and crowd control during the July 4th Celebration.
